

researcher is also expected to write opinion articles, to be published in national and/or international media vehicles.

The researcher has to list CEBRI in the credits of the productions developed during the time he/she acts as a visiting researcher. Still, the researcher should articulate the establishment of partnerships between CEBRI and other similar institutions abroad, defined in common-agreement with CEBRI.

There will be no kind of employment bond between CEBRI and the researcher. However, the researcher may seek to raise funds for the research through the Center (the parameters for the application must be in common agreement for all parts).

CEBRI holds no responsibility for entry visas that may be necessary or any other documentation to legalize the researcher presence in the Country. In addition to that, CEBRI is not responsible

for the researcher's stay in the Country.
